K-12 Children's Event Guidelines

Hum Sub aims to bring programs of the highest quality to an audience of diverse cultures and ethnicity. For the program to be as professional as possible, the following guidelines and policies have been instituted:

- Each performance should be based on the Theme title - **A Confluence of Indian and American Cultures**
- The portrayal of Indian & American Cultures
- Each performance should be a maximum of 4 minutes long
- Solo performances are accepted
- Group performance should be a maximum of 10 participants
- Entire performance should transition smoothly such that one segment flows into another and does not require a break
- Guideline requirements may be waived for exceptional items at the discretion of the Program Committee.
- Only one performance per participant or per group will be accepted
- Participants must be resident of North Carolina, USA

Video Requirements

- Create a Performance Video to make it presentable to Hum Sub Followers
- The individual presentation should not last for more than 4 Minutes
- The video must be uploaded in mp4 format
- Application for participation must be submitted by May 2nd, 2021 11:59 PM ET
- Please upload your video through the application form (see above)

Suggestions for Video Recording

- Shoot the video in landscape mode, in a well-lit place (outdoor / amphitheater / big studios)
- Choose a proper background for the performances (avoid objects in the background like cars, pets, people, etc.)
- When recording Vocal performances the Audio should be of high quality, and the video should clearly show instruments
- Avoid any logos on the video; the Program Committee may disqualify such videos
- Participant names and credits should be at the end of the Video

Age validity

- The minimum age of the participants is 5 years on the day of the show and maximum is 18 years
- Grade: K-12

Dress Code

Participants are prohibited from disruptive, provocative, revealing, profane, vulgar, offensive, obscene or unsafe clothing or bodily appearances.

Don't wear:

- exposed undergarments
- see-through or excessively short, tight or revealing clothes
- bare midriff shirts
- clothing with lewd, indecent or vulgar messages or illustrations
- clothing that advertises products or services illegal to minors

The Program Committee makes the final determination of the appropriateness of costumes.

Selection Process

Based on the quality of performance, the Audio, and the Video quality, the program committee will select the performances for the final show

Post-Performance Recognition

- Each participant will receive a trophy
- Participation certificate can be emailed to individual participants
